Task: Milling machine work on the RHIC limiter box spares

Positive Observations:

- Area is posted "Eye protection required"
- Safety glasses worn my machine operator had side shields installed
- Cutting fluid container was properly labeled (NFPA diamond label)
- User of cutting fluid was aware of (and knew how to obtain) the MSDS for the cutting fluid
- Machine shop was posted "authorized user's only"
- Point of operation guard was installed on machine

Negative Observations:

- Several of the machines in this shop are not bolted to the floor (OSHA requirement)

Recommended corrective actions for negative observations will be assigned and tracked to completion in the ATS family tracking system.
